#### **TO REQUEST A TEAM**

Communities, incident commanders or forests in high wildfire risk areas with an identified mitigation challenge and who are willing to work closely with CMAT during and after deployment may request a CMAT by filling out a submitting a <u>CMAT request form</u>.
